



¹⁴Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd: “Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say. ¹⁵These people are not drunk, as you suppose. ²²“Fellow Israelites, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know. ²³This man was handed over to you by God’s deliberate plan and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross.

²⁴But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him.

GETTING STARTED

1. Do you have any phobias or things that freak you out (i.e., spiders, heights, crowds)?

SERMON OVERVIEW

2. Think back to the sermon. Was there an idea or expression that spoke to you, or was there anything said that challenged or confused you?

DIGGING IN

Take turns reading a couple of verses each from Acts 2:14-24

3. What did Peter say about Jesus of Nazareth?

4. What stood out to you in Peter's speech to the crowd in Acts 2:14-24? What do you find most interesting or impactful about it?

5. In verse 17, Peter quotes the prophet Joel, who talks about God pouring out his Spirit on all people. What do you think this means, and how does it relate to what happened at Pentecost?

6. Peter accuses the crowd of crucifying Jesus, whom he calls "a man attested to you by God with deeds of power" (v. 22). What opposition have you heard from others about who Jesus is?

7. Peter ends his speech by saying that God raised Jesus from the dead (v. 24). On a scale of 1 to 10, how confident do you feel you can explain who Jesus is and why he came? Why?

How confident are you in sharing your testimony of who Jesus is to you with those who don't know Jesus? Why?

9. If you feel fearful or not confident about sharing your faith, where does that fear come from?

What is one way this week you could intentionally build a relationship with non-believers to learn about their story and help guide them toward a deeper relationship with Jesus?
