7. The phrase "on that day" is repeated multiple times in these verses. What significance might this repetition hold, and how does it impact our understanding of God's promises?
8. In what areas of your life do you currently feel a commitment challenge, and how might the promises of God in Haggai 2:20-23 offer encouragement or guidance?
